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# ST. PATRICK'S DAY BROWNIE TRIFLE

### Ingredients

- 1 box Brownie Mix \*plus ingredients on box, 8x8 pan size
- 3.5 oz Instant Vanilla Pudding Mix
- 8 oz Cool Whip
- Green Food Coloring
- Mint Oreo's \*crushed
