# **Residential Training Modules**

Before you start, please read the steps below on How To Complete

## **Overview**

Welcome to the Residential Training Modules for Western PA. These modules cover a variety of topics related to serving consumers with IDD and Autism. This packet includes 13 separate modules that provide you with 28 credit hours of professional development training. You can complete them online and they will be returned to KFS Training Service. A certificate will be issued upon review.

## How To Complete

- Step 1 Launch the Western PA Residential Training Packet
- Step 2 Scroll to the first training module below (Module 1: Autism Spectrum Disorder).
- Step 3 Open the Training Module Documentation by selecting the Blue Link located at the start of each test, example: Open Training Document  $\rightarrow$  Autism Spectrum Disorders
- Step 4 A PDF will open in another tab on your browser.
- Step 5 Read the material in the PDF.
- Step 6 Sign your name at the bottom of each Training Module Certification Sheet.
- Step 7 Go to the next Module.
- Step 8 Once all modules are completed; follow instructions on last page to submit to KFS Training Service for review.

## **Before You Get Started**

- Tip 1 Each module will vary in time to complete. Mobile users should turn device sideways for landscape view.
- Tip 2 You must complete the entire form once you start. Partial forms are not saved for a future session.
- Tip 3 Fields marked with an asterisk (\*) are mandatory fields.
- Tip 4 Please click the yellow Next arrow <sup>1</sup> on the left or the blue box <sup>19</sup> in the upper right hand corner of the screen to search for missing mandatory fields (if any) not completed.
